Fall and Winter children's clothing (sizes 0-14), Halloween costumes, accessories, dress-up clothes, uniforms, games, puzzles, computer games, videos/DVDs, toys**, books for children and parenting, sports equipment, bicycles, yard toys, riding toys, activity centers, diaper bags, bathtubs, potty seats, diaper pails, changing tables, cribs, booster seats, playpens, gates, baby swings, strollers, monitors, bassinets, bouncers, high chairs, exersaucers, toddler beds, guard rails, blankets, bedding, nursery décor.

**Please limit stuffed animals to popular characters only (Pooh, Elmo, Barney, etc.)

NO CAR SEATS (including travel systems)

NO PERSONALIZED ITEMS

(monogrammed items with one letter allowed)

NO BOTTLES or SIPPY CUPS

NO BREAST PUMPS

NO JEWELRY

NO TRINKET-TYPE TOYS

NO HOODED TOPS WITH DRAWSTRINGS

SELLER GUIDELINES

For greater selling success, read carefully and follow these closely!

You will receive 70% of the selling price on all of your items, minus a \$5 participation fee. This fee is used to cover the cost of advertising, mailings, etc. HOWEVER, the fee will be waived if you work two shifts. To sign up for work shifts, contact the Consignor Appointment Leader by completing a Volunteer Work Shift form, located on the Macon MOPS website.

You must fill out a consignor form for an appointment time and consignor number even if you have participated in previous sales. **Visit the www.maconmops.org website** for dates to submit your forms. **Early submissions will be discarded.**

*Consignor "no-shows" or those who cancel the week of the sale will not be allowed to consign for the next two sales. Please make every effort to make your appt

Sellers who consign at least 30 acceptable items will be allowed to shop the Pre-Sale at 6:30pm. In order to shop the Pre-Sale at 5pm, sellers must also work at least one shift. Only newborn children in front pack carriers will be permitted into the pre-sale with you. Other children and guests will not be allowed into the pre-sale.

**ABSOLUTELY NO STROLLERS AT THE PRE-SALE.
LAUNDRY BASKETS/BAGS ONLY!**

RECEIVING PROCEDURES

Clothing items must be sorted by gender and size to expedite the receiving process.

Clothing must be FALL/WINTER or transitional Fall, and in good/excellent, clean condition. NO STAINS, HOLES, TEARS, MISSING BUTTONS, FADED/WORN items. Items will sell best if they are not wrinkled. Limit of 20 items in sizes 0-12 months (per gender). Shoes must be clean and fresh - bring only your best!

Shoes must be clean, like new, and packaged in clear Ziploc type bags with the tag secured to the shoe sole.

Toys and Equipment must be assembled by the consignor (as space allows). They must be CLEAN and in good working condition with batteries included. Toys with small items should be placed in Ziploc bags (taped shut) and then taped securely to the larger piece. Failure to do this may result in the small items becoming separated and lost. Limit of 3 character stuffed animals only and limit of 5 VHS tapes. No limit on DVDs.

Each seller is limited to selling 300 items

PRICING INSTRUCTIONS

Pricing: Please price your items in \$1.00 or .50 increments at 1/4 to 1/3 of the retail price.

**ITEMS WITHOUT A PRICE WILL BE SOLD FOR \$1.00
ITEMS WITHOUT TAGS WILL NOT BE SOLD**

Discounting: If you do not want your items discounted for Half-Price day, then use RED INK on the entire tag (not just the price). DO NOT use pink or orange marker on your tags. The tag must be clearly marked so that both shoppers and check-out workers know that you DO NOT want your items discounted. Please refer to the other side of the brochure for tagging instructions.

QUALITY CONTROL

Our desire is to become the best consignment sale possible. To achieve this goal, we will be checking for any broken or dirty toys/equipment and clothing items with stains, holes, missing buttons, etc. Please save us the time and you the aggravation by checking everything very carefully. Dirty toys and equipment will be rejected. Keep in mind the golden rule of consignment:

Do not bring anything that you would not buy!

Finally, MOPS of Martha Bowman MUMC is not responsible for any lost or stolen items. Unsold items not picked up by 6:00pm on Saturday will be donated to charity. We reserve the right to reject anything that is unsuitable for a church-sponsored sale or anything that might be frightening/offensive to children.

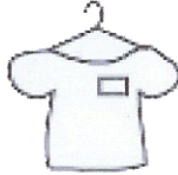
This includes all hats, socks, bibs, washcloths, burp cloths, underwear, training pants, packaged gowns/onesies, rattles, and other small items.

TAGGING INSTRUCTIONS

Tags should be HALF of a 3.5 x 5 inch index card or CARD-STOCK paper. (Plain note paper, scraps of paper, torn paper, and tape are not acceptable and will be rejected at receiving). Tags will be cut off at check-out, so please write the information legibly at least one inch below the safety pin. Please see the illustration for information that should be included on each tag. Tags will be color coded. Please make sure to get your color code from Kim when you make your appointment.

CLOTHING: Each item must have a securely attached, properly sized tag. Do not use S, M, or L (except maternity). If the clothing tag does not have a number size, use your best judgment for the sizing. Hanger must face left, making a question mark. The tag should be safety-pinned (no small gold pins) to the upper right corner of each clothing item. Write your seller number on masking tape and place inside the garment as well.

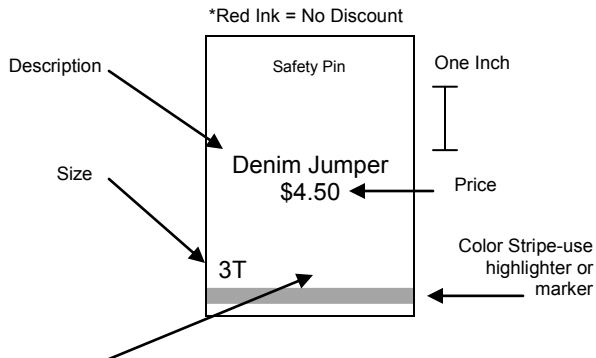


SHOES: Need to be clean, like new, and packaged in clear Ziploc type bags with the tag secured to the shoes.

TOYS/EQUIPMENT: Use packing/masking tape on top and bottom of tag to securely attach tag to item. Do not tape over the writing on the tag.

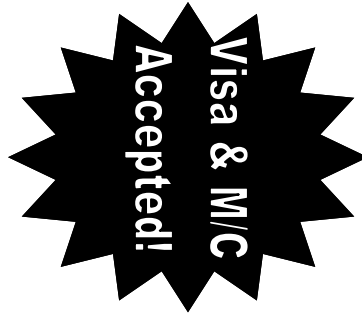
PLEASE FOLLOW THIS TAG EXAMPLE

Seller Code-D if you wish for the item to be donated to charity if it does not sell. If you want it back, leave off the "D".

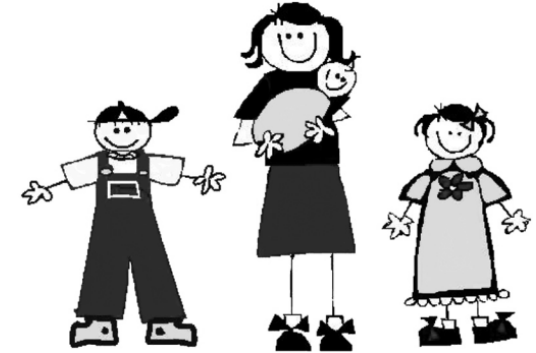
Small items such as socks, bibs, and washcloths will automatically be donated if they don't sell.
